**Virtual Public Meeting
FM 2920 Safety Improvements
From I-45 to North Willow Street
Harris County, Texas
CSJs: 2941-02-062, etc.**

Given the unique circumstance of the COVID-19 outbreak, along with our commitment to protecting public health during this national emergency, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Houston District is conducting this virtual public meeting to avoid in-person contact.

TxDOT is proposing improvements on Farm-to-Market (FM) 2920 from Interstate (I) 45 to North Willow Street in Harris County, Texas. The virtual meeting will be available on the TxDOT website beginning **Tuesday, April 27, 2021 at 4:00 P.M.** To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to www.txdot.gov, keyword search "FM 2920 Safety Improvements". The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded presentation by the project team, project exhibits and other information, and an opportunity to comment. If you do not have internet access, you may call (281) 319-6413 to ask questions about the project and access project materials at any time during the project development process. Formal comments may be provided by mail, online, or email as explained below.

The purpose of the virtual public meeting is to present the proposed project to the public and receive comments. The project extends a total of 11.1 miles along FM 2920 from I-45 to North Willow Street in Harris County. The proposed project includes the installation of continuous raised medians and right turn lanes. The continuous raised medians would only be installed from West of SH 99 to West of I-45. The project would take place within the existing right-of-way on FM 2920 and no displacements are anticipated. Maps showing the project location, drawings illustrating the proposed design, and other information regarding the proposed project are available online at www.txdot.gov, keyword search "FM 2920 Safety Improvements".

The FM 2920 virtual public meeting will be conducted in English and Spanish. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English or Spanish is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
